16. True fellowship is with God, Christ, and the Holy Spirit. Christian fellowship is a by-product that results in spiritual camaraderie among believers. The more theologically in sync two believers are the more meaningful the fellowship.

Philippians 2:1 - [Protasis: expanded translation] If there is any encouragement [parkkihsij, paraklēsis] from one's position in Christ, if there is any comforting sense of well-being [paramúqion, paramuthion] in the love of God, if there is any fellowship [koinwn...a, koinōnia] in the filling of the Holy Spirit, if there are any resultant mental attitudes of compassion [spikgcna, splanchna] and sympathy [ouktirmos], oiktirmos], and there are,

Philippians 2:2 - [Apodosis] bring to completion the same true happiness I enjoy by thinking the same doctrinal principles, maintaining the status quo of personal love for God and occupation with Christ, in harmony of soul with other believers, intent on executing the sophisticated spiritual life.
