

For Christians, the most sacred right contained in the First Amendment is that of free exercise. Ancillary to it are those freedoms that enable a person to grow in grace so he can become a good soldier for Jesus Christ. Freedom of movement facilitates assembly. Freedom of assembly permits church attendance. Freedom of speech allows public exposition of Scripture. Freedom of the press insures the publication and distribution of the Bible and its teachings. Recognizing the importance of a free people having access to the foundational documents of the Republic, these State Papers are a part of this publication.¹

17. Finally, this congregation must take advantage of the privileges and immunities that are cited in the Constitution's First Amendment. The onus is on every member and nonmember who attend either face-to-face or electronically.
18. This is not time to isolate yourself from being current on the study of doctrine. No room is left for internecine squabbles to separate believers from the duty to grow in grace. No outside exigency should prevent the consistent inculcation of the Word of God.
19. Client Nation arrogance should have no place among those who assert they are serious students of the Word of God while at the same time avoid gathering themselves together with other believers for the purpose of joining the advance.
20. In conclusion of Cosmic One Arrogance, we repeat the Lord's warnings found in:
Matthew 5:13 - "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men."
21. Aspire to maintain the status of "the salt of the earth" before the Lord and you will be the "light of the world" (Matthew 5:14a).

26. The Hatred Complex of Cosmic 2 may be summarized by involvement in the following categories of antagonism, not only toward the Word of God, but also toward the laws of divine establishment.

1. **The Sin Nature:** Motivational antagonism toward the Bible.

The believer out of fellowship is manipulated by both inner and overt stimuli from the lust patterns of the sin nature.

The sin nature is referred to in the Bible by the term “flesh” which summarizes Paul’s testimony of how he became aware of the sin nature as a permanent part of his body.
