The Prototype Divine Dynasphere; the Great Power Experiment: Can Jesus Remain Sinless without Use of His Divine Attributes? False Definitions of the Hypostatic Union; Impeccability Confirmed by the Resurrection

The system that provided Him with this power is the eight-gate divine dynasphere:

- 1. The Power Gate, the indwelling and filling ministries of the Holy Spirit activated at the moment of the virgin birth. Isaiah 11:2.
- 2. Objectivity of approaching life and circumstances without the distortion of personal feelings, prejudice, or desires. John 6:38.
- 3. Teachability; the willingness to learn. Luke 2:40.
- 4. Spiritual Momentum, the perception and application of doctrine. Luke 2:52.
- 5. Motivational Virtue: personal love for God. John 14:31; Matthew 22:37.
- 6. Functional Virtue: unconditional love for mankind. Matthew 5:44; 22:39; John 13:34.
- 7. Momentum Testing: People (the human race), Thought (demonic temptations by Lucifer and others), System (Pharisees, et al., and the oral law), Disaster (breakdown of Jewish and Roman systems of justice), and Prosperity (proposed imputation of the sins of the world upon Him).
- 8. Spiritual Maturity: the sophisticated spiritual life. (John 1:14).

This describes the function of the Prototype Divine Dynasphere that was bequeathed to those who believe in Christ during the Church Age as the Operational Divine Dynasphere.

PRINCIPLES:

- 1. To properly understand the prototype system one must be mindful of the two natures of Christ: divine and human.
- 2. The divine attributes are never associated with the function of the prototype divine dynasphere. The functioning of the prototype system is developed in the soul of the Lord as he grew in grace as is indicated in Luke 2:40 and 52.
- 3. If divine attributes were to contribute to His spiritual growth inside the prototype then the integrity of His mission would be compromised.
- 4. The system in which our Lord functioned was imputed to His true humanity only and can be best understood as an experiment.
- 5. An experiment is defined by *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary* as "an operation or procedure carried out under controlled conditions in order to discover an unknown effect or law, to test or establish a hypothesis, or to illustrate a known law."
- 6. The "controlled conditions" are the rules of engagement for the rebuttal phase of the appeal trial of Satan which includes both the Incarnation and the Church Age.
- 7. The "unknown effect" is "discovered" by observation of Jesus Christ's successful use of the prototype by examination of the Gospels.
- 8. The "testing" of the "hypothesis" is performed by the Lord during the course of the Incarnation.

- 9. His successful completion of the experiment "illustrated" the "known law," i.e., the prototype, which the Father designed in eternity past and programmed into the ROM chip of the divine decree.
- 10. False descriptions of the hypostatic union are to be recognized and avoided.
- 11. For example: "The deity of Christ is possessed by the humanity of Christ." To be possessed in this sense is to be influenced or controlled by an outside agent, in this case it is asserted that the true humanity of Jesus was possessed, i.e., influenced or controlled by the deity of Christ. This is incorrect.
- 12. This implies that the Lord's humanity was assisted in his decision making by His deity rather than His personal dependence upon the Holy Spirit and doctrine resident in His soul inside the prototype.
- 13. Another false doctrine of the hypostatic union is that "the deity of Christ indwelt the humanity of Christ." Indwelling means "an inner activating or guiding force" (*Merriam-Webster's*). Again this runs counter to the principle of the prototype which must function under the power of the Spirit and the Lord's personal volition with regard to resident doctrine.
- 14. A third false doctrine is that "Jesus was true humanity but was not God." This is the view held by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latterday Saints, i.e., the Mormons. They use the vocabulary of the Christian church but their own dictionary. Jesus is looked upon as a god among many gods all of which are not of the same essence as the eternal Father. Because of the redefinition of terms it is quite difficult to understand Mormon theology which also serves as a camouflage for its false doctrines.
- 15. A fourth false doctrine is that "Jesus was God but not true humanity." This is ludicrous on its face.
- 16. There are biblical proofs of the necessity for Jesus to be true humanity:
 - (1) In order to be the "Savior" of the human race. Philippians 2:7–8; Hebrews 2:14–15.
 - (2) To be our "Mediator": one who intervenes between conflicting parties to promote reconciliation by representing both sides in the dispute. (1 Timothy 2:5–6)
 - (3) To be our "High Priest." A priest represents man before God. (Hebrews 5:1)
 - (4) To be in the line of David thus fulfilling the Davidic Covenant. (2 Samuel 7:8–16; Psalm 89:28–37)
- 17. The prototype system sustained the humanity of Christ throughout the Incarnation and was proved effective in two ways: (1) propitiation of the Father: the spiritual death of Christ on the cross was declared satisfactory by the Father freeing His justice to reconcile anyone who believes in Him, and (2) the resurrection of Jesus Christ is proof positive that the Father was propitiated by means of His spiritual death.
- 18. The great power experiment conducted in the prototype system began at the virgin birth and terminated at the physical death of Christ.

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
