The Aorist Participles in Ephesians 6:14

The aorist adverbial participle usually denotes antecedent time to that of the controlling verb.*

Verse 14 - <u>Stand fast</u> [ἴστημι (hístēmi): main or controlling verb] therefore, <u>after having buckled</u> <u>around your waist</u> [περιζώννυμι (perizónnumi): aorist adverbial participle] the belt of truth and after <u>having put on</u> [ἐνδύω (endúō): aorist adverbial participle] the breastplate of capacity righteousness, (EXT)
