

The Porphyrian Tree

Anything that exists is a (1) substance: either (2) material or (3) non-material. A material substance has a (4) body, a nonmaterial substance does not.

There are two kinds of material bodies: (5) living and (6) non-living. Living bodies are (7) organisms. Non-living bodies are things like rocks and minerals.

There are two kinds of living, material organisms: (8) sentient, having one or more of the 5 senses, and (9) non-sentient. Sentient organisms are (10) animals while non-sentient ones are plants.

There are many kinds of animal organisms that are sentient: (11) rational and (12) nonrational. The rational, sentient, living, material substance is (13) man. The nonrational, sentient, living, material substances consist of the brute beasts.

Man is rational and logical while the beasts, absent reason, are non-rational and illogical.
