Romans 5:15 -But not as the original sin of Adam is the gift [ the spiritual death of Christ ] that results from grace [ the unfailing love of God ]. For if [εί (ei): introduction to a 1st class condition ] by means of that transgression [  $\pi\alpha\rho\dot{\alpha}\pi\tau\omega\mu\alpha$ (paraptōma): the original sin ] of that one man [ Adam ] the many <u>died</u> [ ἀποθνήσκω (*apothnēskō*): spiritual death ], and they did, [begin apodosis] much more then, to a greater degree—a fortiori—the grace of God and the gift of grace [ δωρεά + χάρις (dōria + charis): the person and work of Christ producing the availability of salvation ] through the one Man, Jesus Christ, who provided superabundance of blessings [ περισσεύω (perisseuō) escrow conveyance in time and therefore eternity ] to the many who are mature believers.
