Three Categories of Sanctification and Justice

SANCTIFICATION	JUSTICE
Positional: Set apart for special service to God and granted spiritual equality at salvation.	Positional: In the plan of God, the believer's point of contact is the justice of God.
Experiential: Through spiritual growth the believer begins to assume the mind of Christ.	Experiential: Orientation and adjustment to the justice of God through positive volition.
Ultimate: Function in the resurrection body absent the distractions of the sin nature.	Ultimate: Total knowledge of the plan of God enables the believer to <i>become</i> justice.
