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- 9. Five years ago, the stage was set to move full bore into socialism with power no longer residing in the states but rather concentrated in the federal government.
- 10. The strategy was for Hillary Clinton to orchestrate the transformation but something entirely unexpected occurred. A non-politician but a rich businessman from New York City joined a gaggle of Republican wannabes running for president. He was not the usually bland, run—of—the—mill Republican.
- 11. Instead, he was as unorthodox as far as politics are concerned. He had ideas about how things ought to be in a free society and said them out loud behind the campaign slogan, "Make America Great Again," to which the citizens voted a resounding, "Amen!"
- 12. Usual politician, Donald John Trump is not. He is, finally, a problem solver, an innovator, yes, a deal maker, his most recent, stunning achievement is the astounding success to bring peace to the Middle East where the region's Arab nations joined Jewish Israel in a Middle East peace agreement.
- 13. President Trump is not the usual smooth-talking yet boring politician but a problem-solver and a deal maker that renewed the power inherent in a free society. Yet his unorthodox personality is disliked by many although his actions have restored American hegemony.
- 14. Trump is to politics as George Patton was to the U.S. Army. In World War II, the American forces were led by General Dwight D. Eisenhower. The British forces were led by Field Marshall Bernard L. Montgomery. Because the Brits had been in the war from its beginning, Eisenhower reluctantly allowed Montgomery to command an attempted invasion of Germany from the Netherlands and dubbed Operation Market Garden.
- 15. Eisenhower knew that Montgomery did not have the military moxie to pull off the attack but because he was the British commander, he allowed the mission to go forward while realizing that the effort would fail.

Almost every feature of Operation Market Garden ... simply affirmed what had already become evident in North Africa, that Montgomery was generally incapable of conducting anything but stolid defenses or attacks with generous lead times, material superiority and no urgent deadline during the battle. One might even go so far as to say that Market Garden showed Montgomery and the army he had led created in the worst possible light, revealing serious lapses in planning and tactical command.

It was indeed a powerful demonstration that Montgomery could not conduct a narrow strike across the Netherlands and into Germany.5

What was ultimately required was for the Allies to get their forces into 16. Germany. That opportunity emerged with the success of the Normandy Invasion, June 6, 1944. It was during the following campaign that a key but unorthodox general was instrumental in the Allies' victory at Bastogne:

> The apogee of Patton's career came with the dramatic sweep of his Third Army across northern France in the summer of 1944 in a campaign marked by great initiative, ruthless drive, and disregard of classic military rules. Patton's armored units were not operational until August 1, almost two months after D-Day, but by the end of the month, they had captured Mayenne [mä yén], Lavál, Le Mans [Le Mān], Reims [rémz], and Châlons [shä lốn].

> In December 1944 the Germans launched a massive surprise counterattack in the Ardennes Forest, encircling the U.S. Airborne Division at Bastogne, Belgium. Supreme Allied Commander General Dwight D. Eisenhower ordered the Third Army to relieve Bastogne, and Patton repositioned his force with astonishing speed. Advance elements of the Third Army reached Bastogne's tenacious defenders on December 26, and additional reinforcements followed over subsequent days. Patton's forces continued to push the German's back, and by the end of January 1945, the Third Army had reached the German frontier. On March 1 those forces took Trier [trir], precipitating one of the most famous exchanges of the war. When Patton received a message instructing him to bypass the city because it would take four divisions to capture it, Patton replied, "Have taken Trier with two divisions. Do you want me to give it back?" Over the next ten days, they cleared the entire region north of the Moselle River, trapping thousands of Germans.<sup>6</sup>

17. Patton was trained in the art of war at the United States Military Academy at West Point. The part of that training that interested him most was the strategy and tactics necessary to suppress and ultimately overwhelm the enemy. Unlike Bernard Montgomery's penchant for a slow, grinding-it-out approach, Patton favored rapid advance and assault designed to overwhelm and exhaust the opposition. Because of the necessary involvement of British armed forces, General Eisenhower tolerated Montgomery, but knew Monty was not capable of successfully leading an army in the fierce encounters demanded in the war with Nazi Germany. Eisenhower needed someone who could penetrate the German defenses and allow the Allies to go all the way to Paris and do it as quickly as possible. The man he turned to was George Patton, commander of the U.S Third Army.

The comparisons that may be applied to the current crisis in the United States calls upon such a personality to illustrate the current crisis. Among the fifteen or so men who ran for president in 2016 were at best Bernard Montgomerys. The opposition was a woman whose ambitions were focused on the transformation of the American system of government into a progressive nightmare. She was so confident she would win against a flamboyant businessman who was best known as the host of a television program that she failed to campaign in several Blue states assuming their electoral votes were hers. The current crisis is orchestrated by those who are in opposition to the documents that founded this nation. These are officially referred to as State Papers and include four elements that establish order within the commonwealth: (1) The Declaration of Independence, (2) The Constitution of the United States, (3) The Bill of Rights, and (4) subsequent Amendments.

These four work in concert to protect and insure the freedom and protection of every citizen. The Declaration's second paragraph begins with these statements:

"We hold these Truths to be self-evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among them are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness that to secure these Rights Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the Consent of the Governed."

The Constitution's Preamble introduces its seven Articles:

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish the Constitution of the United States of America.

The Bill of Rights declares certain specific rights that each citizen of the United States possesses and isolates these rights to such a degree that its opening statement in Amendment I reads, "Congress shall make no law." These rights are said to be held in perpetuity by the phrase found in Amendment's I, II, and IV, "the right of the people.

Currently, two subjects have been expressed by the Blue Party. First, that in an election year, the president cannot nominate, and with advice and consent of the Senate, appoint Judges to the supreme court. Here is how the Constitution reads in Article II, Section 2:

(The President) shall have Power ... to nominate, and by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate, shall appoint Judges of the supreme court.

Also proclaimed by the Blue Party is the admission to the Union of two new states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico. The Constitution has this to report on this idea in Article 5, Section 3:

To be precise about this sentence, Article I, Section 1 defines the term "Congress" as, "All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in 'a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives." So they cried with a loud voice and cut themselves [hithpa'el imperfect of the verb フラネ (gathath): the action of the hithpa'el is intensive, the imperfect tense indicates continuous action ] according to their custom [ロラヴュ (mishpat): "tradition"] with swords and lances until the blood gushed out on them.

The priests of Baal had successfully fooled the people of Israel into believing that their propaganda about a false god was the gospel truth. It was a charade and over the course of one day, Elijah exposed their lies.

The majority of Israel's population had systematically turned away from divine viewpoint and instead became indoctrinated by the Dark Side's cosmic propaganda.

It is now past noon and all their crying and bleeding still failed to solicit a response from Baal yet they continued on unabated indicated by the hithpa'el imperfect of the verb, (nava'): "they raved." This verb generally means "to prophesy," but the hithpa'el imperfect intensified their pleadings as they continuously pled with Baal to start them a fire.

They continued in this wailing until the "offering of the evening sacrifice (3:00 P.M.)." Desperate to successfully solicit Baal's appearance, the priests frantically continued their ravings to Baal while cutting their bodies with lances. This desperate scene continued until they collapsed in futility.

Yet, the priests of Baal had not solicited one flicker of a flame from Baal whose alleged voice had not answered their pleas or even paid them any attention. After all these carryings-on there was no fire under the altar.
