

Operation Hupotuposis: Replicated Deposit, Neural Cache; Summary: Intro

a. Replicated Deposit

2 Timothy 1:13a - Keep on having constellations which form a pattern, mold, or die containing correct doctrinal categories ...

In our study of this verse, we noted that Paul had been successful in depositing into Timothy the Eternal Logos. Timothy had continued his spiritual growth until he reached Santa Fé: he had a facilitated neural network “*containing correct doctrinal categories.*”

The word *hupotuposis* is translated “*pattern, mold, or die,*” and refers to the physical structure of one’s neural pathways which contain the precise replication of the Eternal Logos.

Under the didactical process of GAP, when a teacher teaches, the Holy Spirit takes the information believed on by the student and circulates it into the seven compartments of the stream of consciousness.

In order for the believer to retain the information for continued spiritual growth, the Holy Spirit utilizes the soul's Memory Center in order to access the body’s brain for long-term memory storage. Here He lays down wheel-tracks of righteousness, precisely correct doctrinal data which is a replication of the knowledge contained in the Eternal Logos.

Every time a qualified teacher instructs a positive student, it results in the replication from one soul to another of the exact content of the Eternal Logos. Once the deposit is transferred, the believer with this new knowledge has the same pattern, mold, or die in his brain which is possessed by his teacher. When he then teaches what he knows to others the process is repeated and the information is again replicated by the Holy Spirit.

We have named this Operation *Hupotuposis*. This is how the Eternal Logos is passed down from one generation to the next.

Each time the deposit is transferred through the Divine Academy of Grace Didactics, that deposit is replicated into the neural network of the student. This process has continued undiluted from the time of our Lord’s childhood down to us as beneficiaries in the final decade of the 20th century.

b. Neural Cache

There is a wonderful example of how this perfect transfer of the deposit occurred in the first century of the Church Age.

1 Thessalonians 1:1 - Paul and Silvanus and Timothy to the church of the Thessalonians ...

1 Thessalonians 1:5 - ... our gospel did not come to you in word only [here logos refers to the communication of doctrine] but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

1 Thessalonians 1:6 - You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word [logos] in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit.

Please note what Paul writes. He tells us that the believers at the church in Thessalonica have become imitators of him, Timothy, and Silvanus, and of the Lord.

This takes Operation *Hypotuposis* back to the Incarnation and follows it through the Lord's instruction of Paul in heaven, Paul's transfer from himself to Timothy and Silvanus, and their collective deposit of the Eternal Logos into the neural networks of believers in Thessalonica.

The word translated “imitators” is the plural noun *mimetes*. This is defined by the lexicons and dictionaries as, “imitators, mulators, and to use as a model.”

The believers at Thessalonica used what they learned from Paul and his associates as a model for their behavior. With their neural caches fully facilitated they, in turn, became models to others.

1 Thessalonians 1:7 - so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.

c. Conclusion

The Eternal Logos has been successfully replicated into the neural caches of believers from the first century down to ours. We possess the same wheel-tracks of righteousness in our neural networks as did our Lord in the Incarnation. Replicated Deposit; Neural Cache.

III. Summary of the Logos Deposit

It is important for us to realize the importance of our Lord's entry into human history. We rightly emphasize the fact that His primary mission was to provide our so great salvation. But once saved what become our mission? How should we then live, once saved?

I was recently asked, “*If Christ was perfect, sinless, and filled with wisdom and knowledge, how can we follow Him as a Prototype if we are imperfect, sinful, and, by comparison, doctrinally ignorant?*”

Here's the answer. Good question, wrong rationale. Jesus' job was to maintain perfection until He could get to the cross so that He might qualify as our substitute. His mission was to get to the cross. Our mission is to get to Santa Fé.

The Lord had to maintain perfection. We are to attain experiential sanctification. Jesus started out without any association with sin. We started out totally depraved.

Through His work on the cross, Jesus became sin for us. As a result, the power of our sinful nature has been broken. His prototype demonstration of the Divine Power System displayed how the system kept Him perfect. We may use that same system, not to maintain perfection, but to maintain status-quo spirituality.

He knew no sin. We have a constant battle with the SWAT Team, the sinful nature, and sin itself. He used the system as a youth to grow in grace and, later as our High Priest, to demonstrate the power of the Eternal Logos in the Devil's world. We need the system in order to acquire knowledge of the Eternal Logos and access the power to apply its content.

In the same manner that Jesus Christ grew in grace as a youth, we may grow in grace as a babe in Christ.

God in His grace has seen fit to develop a sequence of deposits and caches which once completed transfers the deposit of the Eternal Logos into our neural networks.

In order for the divine thinking of God to be transferred from His eternal and infinite essence into our temporal and finite brains there had to be initiated a series of divinely administered deposits:
